# CLIA'S ENTRY-LEVEL CERTIFICATION CURRICULUM

The University Licensing Program is derived from CLIA's **Certified Cruise Counsellor (CCC) Certification**, developed to provide agents who are new to the cruise-selling industry with foundational training and education to develop the knowledge-base and skills necessary to increase their sales and ensure their success.

The Certified Cruise Counsellor Certification requires the successful completion of specific foundational courses, along with other criteria specific to the cruise selling business.

Students enrolled through CLIA's University Licensing Program are not expected to meet the certification requirements specific to stateroom sales and ship inspections, however, should the student decide to pursue a career as a travel agent (and become an active CLIA Individual Agent Member with an active CLIA Agency Member), then that student would simply need to complete the remaining certification requirements to receive their CCC. And, because the student will have been a graduate of the University Licensing Program, CLIA will waive the student's certification enrollment fee (presently valued at \$59).

Enrollment into this certification program and the purchase of the mandatory and elective courses costs a CLIA Individual Agent Member \$410 – so your students not only receive the same industry-touted "gold standard" training as our CLIA members, they also receive a significant savings.





# UNIVERSITY LICENSING CORE COURSES

The core courses for this program are derived from the courses required to complete CLIA's Certified Cruise Counsellor (CCC) certification. These courses are updated annually. #### LIVE TRAINING AT YOUR CAMPUS

\$5,000 TRAINER FEE AND TRAVEL, PLUS \$99 PER STUDENT

For a minimum of 50 students, a CLIA trainer will visit your campus and conduct training for n more than two days. This can include a certificate program and/or three ULP electives. The cost per student would be \$99.00 for the Certificate Program and/or \$99.00 for the ULP electives. Subject to availability. Training cost is a \$5,000 trainer fee and travel costs (airfare and hotel room and tax) for the trainer.

# READY TO GET STARTED?

## HERE'S THE PROCESS FOR ESTABLISHING THE UNIVERSITY LICENSING PROGRAM AT YOUR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY:

- Submit your college or university's written request to participate in the program and provide student count for the program year.
- CLIA will invoice the school or designated school contact.
- Once payment has been confirmed, CLIA will reach out to College or University with instructions for the students to set up their MyCLIA accounts.
- Once students have set up their accounts, the eight (8) courses will be added to each student's account.
- The student has six (6) months from the date of enrollment to complete the courses.
- CLIA professional development staff will provide regular reports to help you keep track of your students' progress.


