

THE RISK OF VIOLENT CRIME ON CRUISE SHIPS IS 95% LOWER

COMPARED TO A TYPICAL CITY IN THE UNITED STATES*



A study of four years of violent crime* data by renowned criminologist Dr. James Alan Fox shows that the rate of violent crime per 100,000 people is 95% lower on board cruise ships than on land.
