Port of Seattle



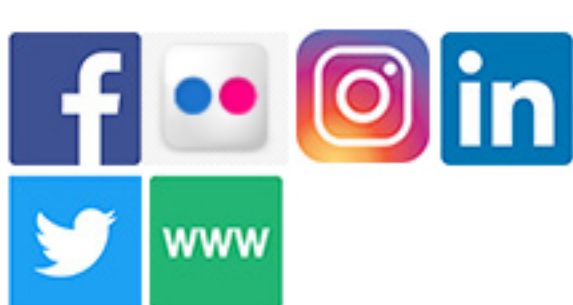
Since 1999, the Port of Seattle has emerged as a premier cruise hub for Alaska and Pacific Northwest Cruises providing a deep-water port that accommodates some of the largest vessels in the world. The Port operates the largest and fastest growing cruise terminals on the West Coast, with more than 200 vessels calling between May and October and serving more than one million passengers every year since 2017.

Seattle's spectacular natural setting, easy access to Sea-Tac airport, and leadership on the West Coast has captured 45% of the Alaska cruise market as homeport to seven cruise brands sailing from Bell Street Cruise Terminal and Smith Cove Cruise Terminal. Plans are underway to develop a new state-of-the-art cruise facility to provide a fourth cruise berth in Seattle with continued priority in environmental stewardship, local provisioning, and supplier partnerships. This year is significant as the Port celebrates 20 years of cruise in Seattle.

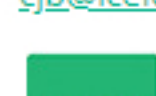

PUBLIC AFFAIRS UPDATE

No Venice Ban

There is currently no ban in place preventing cruise ships from visiting Venice. Discussions concerning the future of cruise ships using the Giudecca Canal have been ongoing for several years and those discussions continue today without any conclusion.

Danilo Toninelli, The Italian Minister for Transport speaking in the Italian Parliament yesterday reported that he has set up a working group to look at alternative solutions which could see some ships rerouted to the mainland Fusine and Lombardia terminals, until the end of the year, but no decision has been made.

"The cruise industry has worked diligently with the Minister, the Mayor of Venice, the Veneto Region, the Port Authority and many other stakeholders to find viable solutions to allow larger cruise ships to access the Maritime berths without transiting the Giudecca Canal. We are still in agreement with the solution developed by Comitatore in 2017 to utilize the Vittorio Emanuele Canal as the best and most prudent means to move larger cruise ships away from the Giudecca," said Tom Boardley, Secretary-General of Cruise Lines International Association Europe. "CLIA cruise line members welcome and will support the urgent implementation of this solution."

MARITIME POLICY UPDATE

North Atlantic Right Whale Protection

To date in 2019, there have been eight confirmed North Atlantic Right Whale deaths, with two attributed to ship strikes. As a result, Transport Canada recently increased the area within the Gulf of St. Lawrence subject to the 10-knot speed restriction. Research and discussions are taking place to consider possible additional measures including restrictions in the area of Cabot Strait, monitoring capabilities, deployment of infrared technology and hydrophones, and training and deployment of on-board whale observers. Members of the CLIA Northwest and Canada Technical Committee are engaged with a view toward promoting the use of technology to monitor real time whale distribution and employing dynamic shipping lane management while avoiding mandatory measures with negative impacts on itineraries and port calls.




