



Research and discussions are taking place to consider possible additional measures including restrictions

## in the area of Cabot Straight, monitoring capabilities, deployment of infrared technology and hydrophones, and training and deployment of on-board whale observers. Members of the CLIA Northwest and Canada Technical Committee are engaged with a view toward

promoting the use of technology to monitor real time whale distribution and employing dynamic shipping lane management while avoiding mandatory measures with negative impacts on itineraries and port calls.


